<p><b>Directions:</b> Half way between Mullaley and Tambar Springs, turn up the Nombi Road (near the Cox’s Creek). Follow for 20.1km (do not take turnoffs to the left or right) The road goes from tar to gravel, and at one stage the main part of the road turns to the left, but you need to keep going straight on the smaller road. Newstead is on your right as you come down a hill 5.6km after the Tambar Springs turn off at the Wyuna silos (where the main part of the road turns to the left.)</p>
<p><b>Accomodation:</b> Coonabarabran or Gunnedah. There is a caravan park with cabins at Mullaley. There is plenty of floor space for those with a swag at Newstead.</p>
